Guidelines for Completing an Affidavit of Mistreatment

Please read instructions carefully before you prepare your statement. The United States Embassy will assist you with any questions you may have.

Guidelines for completing an Affidavit of Mistreatment

Please answer everything. Do not leave any blanks.

Description of the mistreatment:

- Provide exact location where mistreatment occurred:

City or town, private home, office, in a car, etc. If you were transferred to different locations, indicate approximately distance from one place to another, how you were transported, how many times, etc.
- Provide as much detail as possible regarding the mistreatment.
- How many times, and for how long, were you mistreated. Describe the various types of mistreatment you received.

Identification of the perpetrators:

- Provide full names, whenever possible, such as nick names, officers' tag or badge numbers, detailed physical description, etc.
- Describe any peculiarities that would assist in locating/identifying the persons who did the mistreatment, such as all possible identifying marks on face or body like tattoos, scars, skin stains, missing fingers, special behavior, voice, language spoken, type of clothing and shoes worn, etc.

Consular notification:

If you were not allowed to communicate with a United States Consul, indicate who you informed of your United States citizenship; when and how many times you were denied access to consular authorities; and the reason you were given for not allowing you to contact the consular officer.

Additional comments:

Please include any additional details or information which would better describe the situation and assist us and the Indian authorities in identifying those responsible for your mistreatment. Please also indicate whether or not you want to be examined by a doctor at this time.

Affidavit of Mistreatment

I, Colette Smith, a citizen of the United States
by birth/naturalization (circle one), being duly sworn, hereby declare that:

I was arrested in Delhi, India on 01 / / 2015;

I was mistreated at Delhi Airport, IGIA on 01 / / 2015;

By: NCB officer who arrested me.

And that such mistreatment consisted of: As I was getting into the
police vehicle and my foot was getting into
the door, the officer kicked me four times
in my leg. He slapped my face. He slammed
my laptop closed & slammed my cell phone
from my hand as I was speaking to the
US Embassy. During the car ride, he threatened
to torture me. He asked me if I have
ever been tortured and if I am "ready".

This incident took place at IGIA international
departure, gate 6 in the presence of the
immigration officers, who were very happy
to see me arrested. I felt very frightened
and scared of this NCB officer who abused
me and threatened to torture me.

I cannot (circle one) identify those who mistreated me. They were: NCB
officer who arrested me

I did not (circle one) inform Indian authorities that I was a citizen of the United States.

I did not (circle one) ask to speak to the American Embassy.

I was was not (circle one) allowed to contact the American Embassy.

Describe the response you received from the authorities: The police did not allow me to call my lawyer or my embassy. even though I asked repeatedly to do so.

I do not (circle one) authorize the Embassy of the United States of America in India to protest my mistreatment to the proper authorities.
